



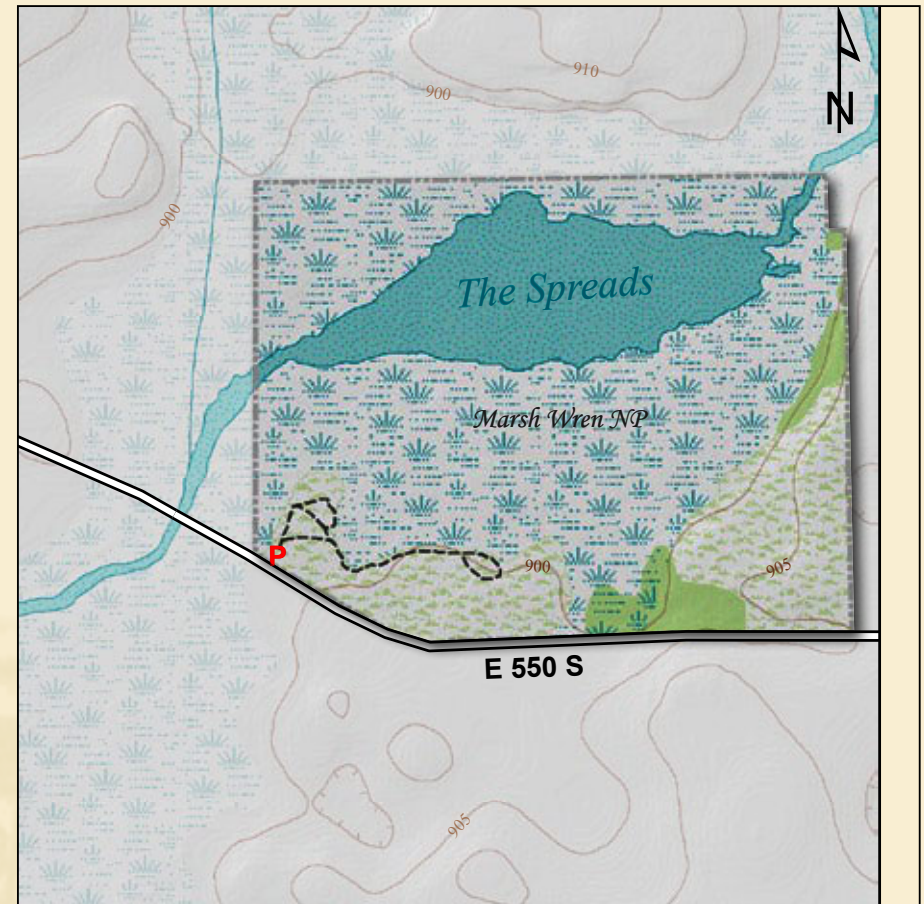
Massasauga Rattlesnake

This is a preserve to be explored by those who are unafraid of snakes. In this preserve live endangered Massasauga rattlesnakes. Also here, as the name indicates, live marsh wrens, another endangered species in Indiana.

Directions:

From LaGrange, take SR 9 south 6.75 miles to 600S and turn right (west). Travel 1.75 miles and turn right (north) onto 125E. Continue ½ mile to 550S and turn left (west). Preserve is on the right in 1.25 miles.
