This is a woodland noted for its varied topography and great variety of wildflowers. Visitors may see blossoms of puttyroot, blue cohosh, creeping euonymous or "heart's-a-busting," sharp-lobed hepatica, wild ginger, Jack-in-the-pulpit and wild leeks. There are also sensitive fern and at least five varieties of sedge.

Directions:

From LaGrange, take US 20 west 10.35 miles to 900W and turn left (south). Preserve is on the left in 1 mile.
