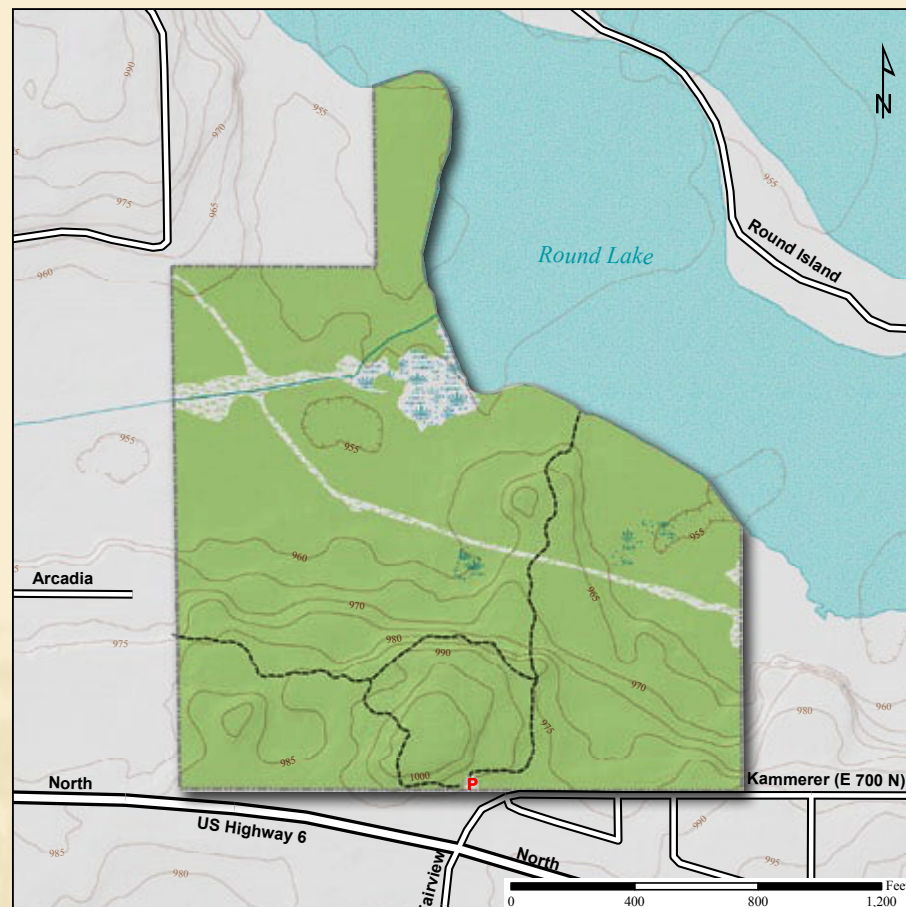

This was a "Green Grocer" farm where vegetables were grown and sold to people of Kendallville and the area. Now trees, including many redbuds, grow where corn and beans and other produce once grew. Round Lake forms a wetlands boundary along the northeast part of the preserve. Plants, in addition to the trees, include shrubby cinquefoil, red osier dogwood, cattails and sedges. Birds are as varied as the plants, and deer are frequently seen.

Directions:

From Kendallville at US 6 and Main St., travel approximately 1.0 mile east to Kammerer Rd. (700N) and turn left (north). Preserve is immediately on the left.
