On the north side of Ball Lake, this preserve includes low wetland forest. Partridgeberry and other plants that were likely carried here by the glaciers grow beneath the trees, and marsh marigold and skunk cabbage grow in the wetland.

**Directions:**

From Hamilton at SR 427, take Bellefontaine Rd. northwest 1.75 miles to Lane 101 and turn left (south). Preserve is on the right in 1/4 mile.
