Swift Long-Winged Skimmer on Cutleaf Coneflower

Beechwood is adjacent to Pokagon State Park and has a mixture of habitats including beech-maple forest; yellow birch, red maple, red elm and blue beech trees; rolling meadows; thickets with dogwood, poison sumac, elderberry and spicebush, and a bog. Birds and wildflowers are as varied as the cover.

Directions:

From Angola, take SR 127 north and travel under I-69 towards Pokagon State Park at exit 154. SR 127 turns to the right (north) just before the Pokagon State Park entrance. Continue north on SR 127 for ¼ mile to Lane 150. Preserve is on the left.

This preserve can also be accessed through Pokagon State Park on trail 8.
